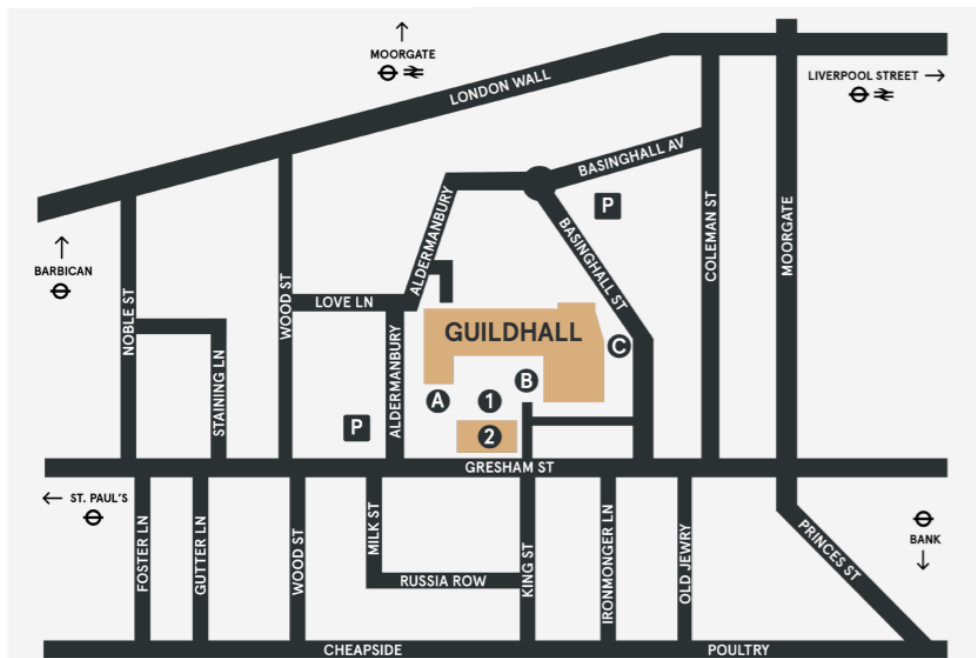

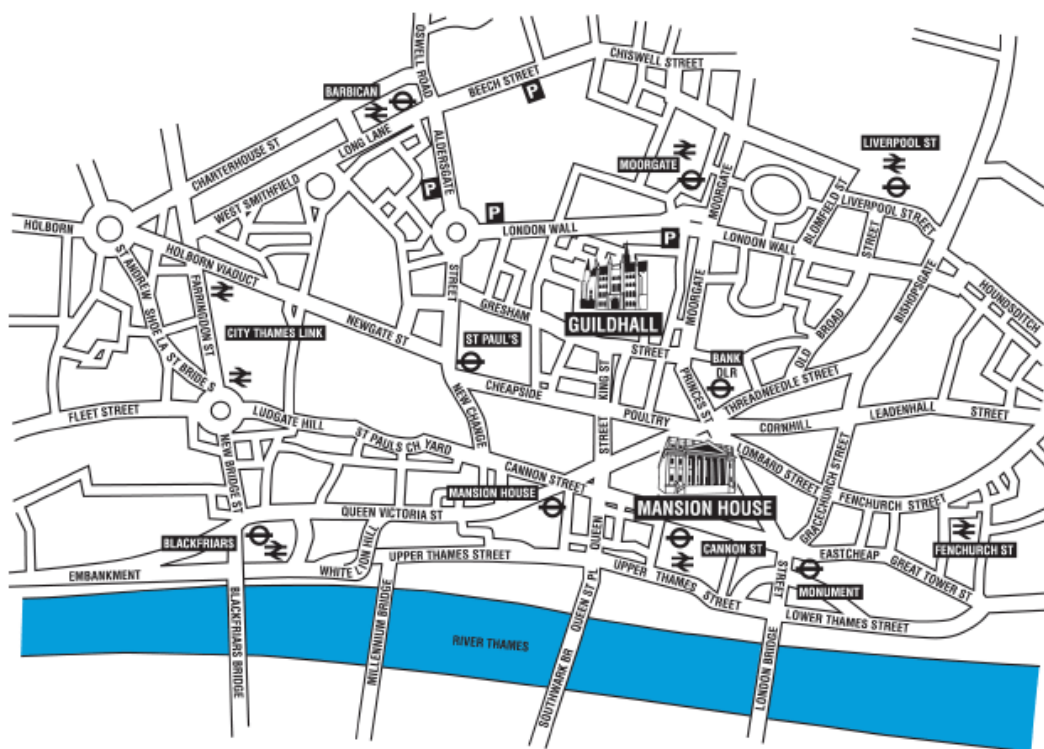
Delegate Registration

The event will be held in The Old Library & Print Room, Guildhall, London EC2V 7HH. Delegate entry will be via the [Guildhall Art Gallery](#). To access the Gallery please go via the Guildhall Yard, via Gresham Street (marked entrance B on the map below).



Delegate registration and breakfast will take place from **08.45am** in the corridor which leads to the Old Library. Bags checks will be in operation so please aim to be at the venue by **9.00am at the latest** to allow time to complete your registration before the start of the conference.

Getting to the venue



It is recommended that you use public transport to travel to the Guildhall:

By Tube: Bank, St Paul's, Mansion House and Moorgate

By Bus: Bank 11, 23, 26, 388; Moorgate 21, 43, 76, 133, 141; Cheapside 8, 25, 242; and London Wall 100.

By Train: Liverpool Street, Cannon Street, Fenchurch Street, Moorgate, Blackfriars and City Thameslink.

Please refer to the Transport for London [Journey Planner](#) to plan your route and allow enough time for your travel. If you are driving to the Guildhall, please follow directions to the Guildhall Library. Postcode **EC2V 7HH**.

Nearest car parks: London Wall 24 hours; Barbican 08.00-24.00; and Aldersgate 24 hours

Disabled parking: Designated parking bays are located in Aldermanbury, Basinghall, Gresham and Coleman streets. Maximum stay four hours Monday to Friday.
